<ul> <li>Make sure you can reach your water, electrical, and sewer hookups</li> <li>Bonus: Plug a surge protector into your electrical outlet to make sure your site power is working properly, and check that your water is on, too. If you'll need to move, it's much better to find out while you're still hooked up!</li> <li>Make sure you can put your slides out without hitting obstacles</li> <li>Make sure your RV is level right to left</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Now, proceed to your setup checklist:</li> <li>Chock your tires</li> <li>Disconnect from tow vehicle. <i>Remove chains last</i></li> <li>Level front to back</li> <li>Deploy stabilizers</li> <li>Connect to shore power</li> <li>Check inside and outside for obstacles before operating slides</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Connect to city water</li> <li>Connect Internet or cable</li> <li>Connect sewer hose</li> <li>It's best practice to leave grey and black valves closed until full and dump black beofre grey.</li> <li>Turn on water heater</li> </ul>
