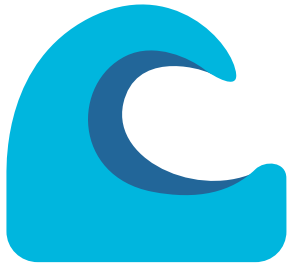

# TOP 7 RV TRIPS IN 10 DAYS

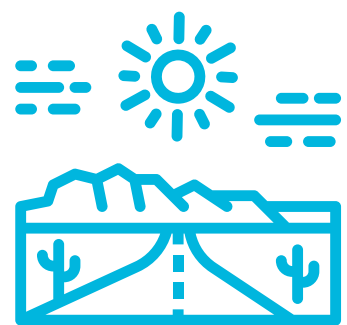


## THE CENTRAL COAST

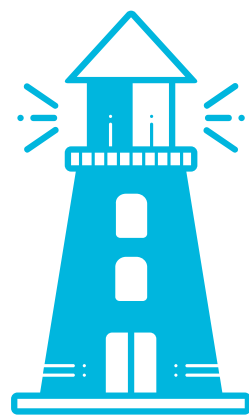


## THE MOUNTAIN STATES

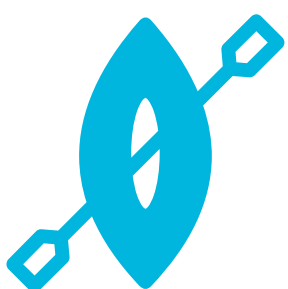
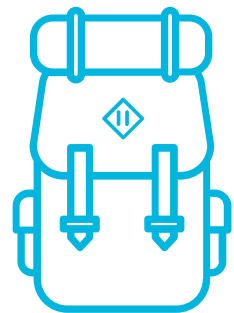


## UPPER EAST COAST
